a private general medical clinic. there is a one month wait for general medical appointments, but they have drop-in, same-day urgent care appointments available, including stitches, casts, etc. Spanish and Laotian translation available. \$109 for first appointment plus any tests, \$85 per appointment for subsequent ones. general physicals range from \$165-\$200, varies based on age, expensive shit.

The only Medi-cal they accept is Contra Costa Medi-cal. Prescriptions are written on site, but must be picked up at an outside pharmacy.

Drop-in happens Mon, Wed, Fri beginning at 8:30a and serves the first 10 people (adults) **DO NOT NEED TO BE MEMBERS, JUST NEED CA ID.** Must be URGENT. Sliding Scale is generally 10% of monthly income. If it is NOT urgent wait is 2-3 months for membership. Prescriptions are written and provided on site.

Offers both TB tests (sliding scale) and physicals.
